Universidad Panamericana is a private nonprofit research university founded in 1967. It has three main campuses and 6 branch campuses in Aguascalientes, Guadalajara, and Mexico City.

Universidad Panamericana currently offers 43 undergraduate programs and over 128 graduate programs, with 15,200 undergraduate and graduate students served by 2,657 faculty (38% with PhD) and more than 1,000 staff members.

# RESEARCH

Since 2019, UP has the private Mexican university with the second-highest number of publications indexed in Scopus.

The number of UP Faculty members officially registered in Mexico's National System of Researchers has increased by 191% since 2016.

During the 2015-2021 period, UP's scientific production increased by 317%.

In 2022, 56% of the scientific production was published in high-quality journals (Q1-Q2).




# INNOVATION AND TECHNOLOGY

AGUASCALIENTES Campus

UP's Aguascalientes Campus was founded in 1989 in the former country state Ojocaliente region. It currently has two branch campuses, hosting 2,451 undergraduate and graduate students.

The Aguascalientes region is known for its gentle climate and relaxed provincial character. As the state's capital city bearing the same name, this attractive colonial city is today a burgeoning commercial and industrial center.

The state has achieved high commercial status, producing a large proportion of Mexico's high-tech manufacturing output. Recently, companies such as Texas Instruments, Xerox, and Nissan have opened facilities in Aguascalientes, contributing to growth in the manufacture of electronics, mechanical products and automobiles, and in metal mining.




GUADALAJARA Campus

The Guadalajara Campus was built between 1930 and 1940 and currently hosts over 5,215 students, including undergraduate and graduate programs. The campus stands out for its modern architecture and first-rate facilities, including laboratories, sports courts, and a gym.

Guadalajara is the capital city of the state of Jalisco. The city is located in the central region of Jalisco, in the western Pacific area of Mexico.

With a population of 5 million people, it is Mexico's second most populous municipality. Guadalajara is also the 10th largest city in Latin America.

The city is named after the Spanish city of Guadalajara, which came from an Andalusian Arabic name meaning "valley of stones."



Mixcoac Campus

Mexico City campus hosts over 7,600 students in a beautiful building complex featuring both colonial (an old textile factory from the XVIII Century) and modern buildings.

This campus has university life areas, such as multi-purpose rooms, a gym with cardio and a strength area, a food court, and coffee shops. It also houses an auditorium, a library, laboratories, and a photography studio.

Occupying a privileged location in the central south of Mexico City, Universidad Panamericana offers students ample opportunity to discover the city — it is only five minutes away from one of the city's main avenues, connecting a variety of public transport alternatives — while remaining within a quiet neighborhood surrounded with parks, malls, and residential buildings.



MEXICO CITY Ciudad UP Campus

Located in Bosque Real, in western Mexico City, this new campus was launched in April 2020, with its first major building set on 40 acres of land that will eventually host over 10,000 students.

Ciudad UP Campus is a long-term project (15-20 years) that will feature a hospital, research facilities, sports areas, university residences, a museum, laboratories, and other educational facilities.

Today, Ciudad UP's first building consists of 21,000 meters with a capacity for 1,200 students from the Business & Management, Law, Economics, Government, and Quantitative Finances programs. All programs include in their curricula the experience of international weeks abroad.

Ciudad UP Campus has sports areas that include a multi-court, a gym, and 2 paddle courts. It also houses a library, an auditorium, social and leisure areas, coffee shops, a library, and a parking lot.



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
